I am opposed to 614 University Avenue nightclub because of the wall-shaking sound I and my roommate had to endure until 12:10am yesterday on a Sunday night. We live in an apartment directly above the club, and have been living here for the mast couple of years. Regardless of the time of day, the sound level was ridiculous, and it was uncomfortable to sit in our own living room without headphones on to block the sound. As students at the University with class early Monday morning, this is extremely disruptive to our sleep schedules because it is utterly impossible to sleep while the club is in full swing as it was last night. It has not been open for long enough to know how long it will be open other nights, and I was not able to call due to the absence of a website for the bar, but I foresee this being a major inconvenience in the future especially since I am committed to this lease until mid-August. I was not able to determine the law regarding this in the noise ordinance of Madison due to its lengthiness, but I would like to be sure the bar, at a minimum, follows the law, and hopefully this means being less obnoxious than it has been this past week if it is here to stay.
