

DRAFTER'S ANALYSIS: This ordinance establishes penalties for violation of Sec. 9.24, MGO, Licensing of Secondhand Dealers. It establishes a 2nd and 3rd offense penalty for individuals that continue to violate the ordinance.

The Common Council of the City of Madison do hereby ordain as follows:

Subdivision (a) of Subsection (3) entitled "Schedule of Deposits" of Section 1.08 entitled "Issuance of Citations for Violations of Certain Ordinances and Providing a Schedule of Cash Deposits" of the Madison General Ordinances is amended by creating and amending therein the following:

<u>Failure to comply with secondhand dealer mall or flea market requirement.</u>	<u>9.24(9)</u>	<u>\$150, 1st</u> <u>\$500, 2nd</u> <u>\$1000, 3rd/more"</u>
