The Lake Monona Waterfront master plan and corresponding report represent the outcome of an ambitious, multi-year planning initiative. The process was led by the thirteen-member Lake Monona Waterfront Ad-hoc Committee, and through their direction, plan development centered on the community goals of creating a visionary, inclusive, and environmentally focused waterfront.
