1. Education and Community Services Committee combines Early Childhood Care and Education Committee, Education Committee, Committee on Aging, and Community Services Committee.
2. Housing, Community, and Economic Development Committee combines the Housing Strategy Committee, Economic Development Committee, Landlord Tenant Issues Committee, and Community Development Division Conference Committee.
3. Environment and Sustainability Committee combines Committee on the Environment, Solid Waste Advisory Committee, Sustainability Committee, and Sustainable Madison Committee.
4. To be accompanied by new ordinance outlining process for creating an ad hoc committee, including requirements that the ad hoc committee be formed to address a specific issue, its jurisdiction be limited to that issue, it has a report date, and that no ad hoc committee may exist for longer than 24 months.
5. Recommend, where possible, removing multi-jurisdictional committees, Monona Terrace committees, and Overture Committees from the MGOs if they are not truly city committees.
6. Awards Committee combines the Erlanger Award and MLK Jr. Award Committees
7. Eliminate the Golf Committee and Warner Park Recreation Committee and assign those duties to the Facilities and Programming Committee.
8. Forestry and Stewardship Committee combines the Urban Forestry and Habitat Stewardship Committees
9. Recommends elimination of the Sweat Free Purchase Committee (assign duties to staff), Digital Technology Committee (assign duties to staff), Weed Commissioners (assign duties to staff); Sister City Committee (should be an NGO); Bayview Foundation (should be an NGO), and Triangle and Monona Bay Foundation (should be an NGO).
