Hello,

At tonight's meeting you will be discussing the High Point-Raymond Neighborhood Development plan. I am asking that you consider removing the Jeffy Trail street extension from that plan. This proposed street extension is concerning for multiple reasons.

First, it creates a "cut-through" from the very busy County M, which will soon be under construction. The High Point arterial should be completed instead to manage this traffic.

Second, the existing, paved path is very popular and gets used frequently. We value the space as it is. It's a beautiful wooded area purchased from the Audubon Society where we see a variety of wildlife.

Third, if the proposed extension goes through, it blocks access to the Ice Age Trail as well as a popular route to Flagstone Park. This creates a less safe route for the youth in our neighborhood who use the current trail for bike rides and trips to the park.

Please remove the Jeffy Trail street extension from the High Point-Raymond Road Plan.
