Paratransit Service Changes

On Wednesday, October 11, Metro Transit and the City of Madison Transit and Parking Commission will hold a public hearing at 6 PM to discuss several proposed changes to Metro's paratransit service.

Proposed changes include:

- Fare increase to \$4.00 per trip
- Elimination of paratransit convenience tickets. Fare becomes cash only.
- Transition to strictly Origin to Destination service - curb to curb mode
- Elimination of "leave attended" ride options
