Capital Budget Instructions:

• Reduce CIP requests where possible. Potentially complete projects on a smaller scale.

• Requests for new projects or increased funding will be subject to additional review.

- New projects must demonstrate how they improve the lives of residents who have been historically marginalized, reduce greenhouse gas emissions and promote climate resilience.
- Take a realistic approach to the number of projects we can get done, taking into account staff capacity.
- Agencies can request a 5% increase to program budgets in 2023.
- Agencies should look to pare down projects wherever possible.

2025 Capital Budget Request Highlights:

- Capital Collections increases 2030 by allowable 5%.
- Major Repair/Replacement increases 2030 by allowable 5%.
- Reduction in 2025 request by \$152,000 for work completed in advance of 2025, supported by the Foundation, Friends, Endowment funds and ARPA funds.
- No change from 2024 request for 10-Plus Year Flooring Replacement.
