

Q2 How often, if ever, do you typically golf at any of the four City of Madison Golf Courses (Glenway, Monona, Odana, or Yahara)?





Q3 In the past 5 years, have you golfed at any of the following? Select all that apply.





Q4 Which course do you play the most?






Q5 How many holes of golf do you typically play per round?



I do this to evaluate the differences of the 2 courses. It would be a shame to close a beautiful course like Monona. This course should be profitable with very little effort. 

Q9 For these non-golf activities, which courses have you used within the past 5 years? Check all that apply.





Q11 What is your opinion of the number of golf holes offered by the City of Madison golf courses?







Q13 What is your age?





Q14 Which gender do you most closely identify?





Q15 Which of the following racial and ethnic group(s) do you most closely identify?




