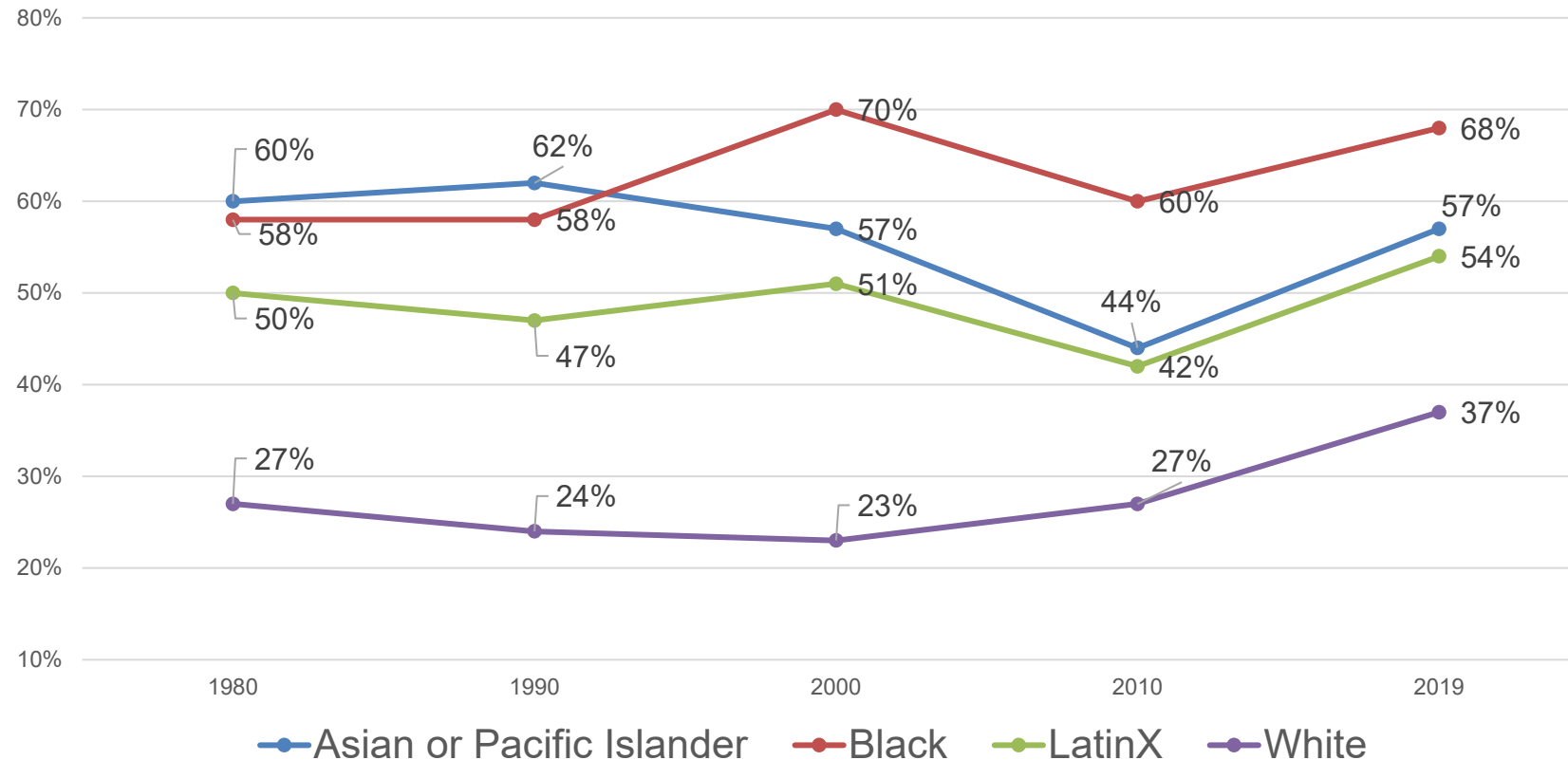

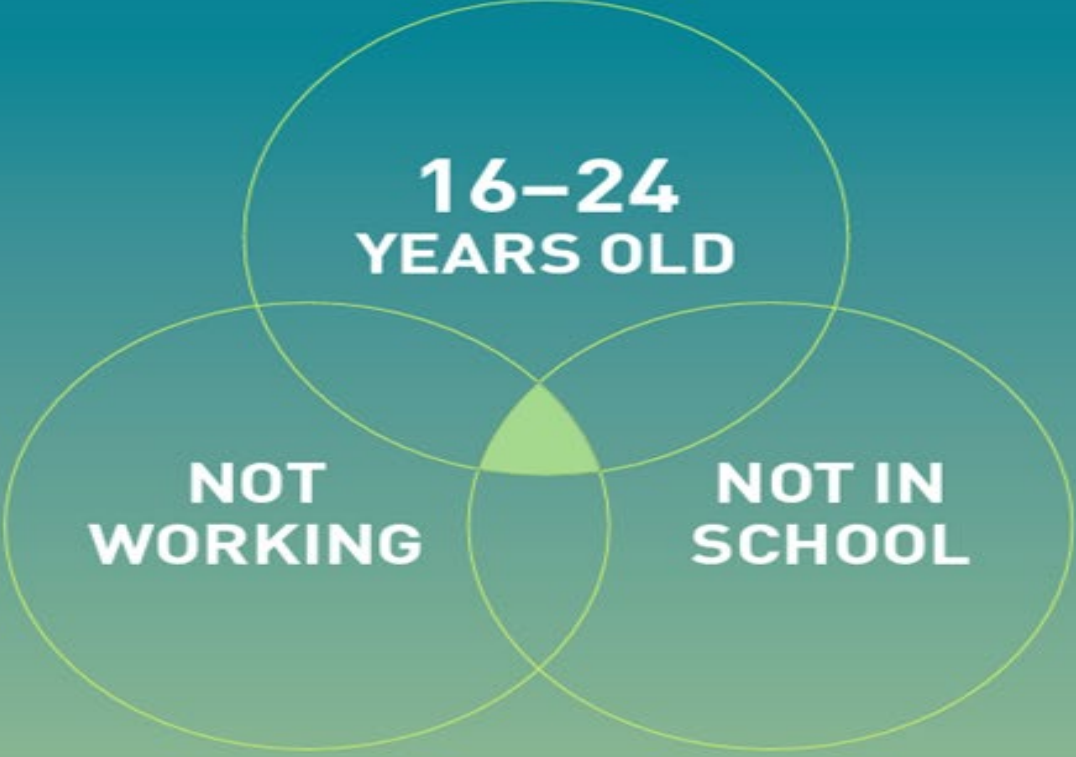
*Support a **continuum** of employment opportunities for youth, young adults, and adults that has the ability to support **multiple levels of internships, work readiness and employment opportunities.***

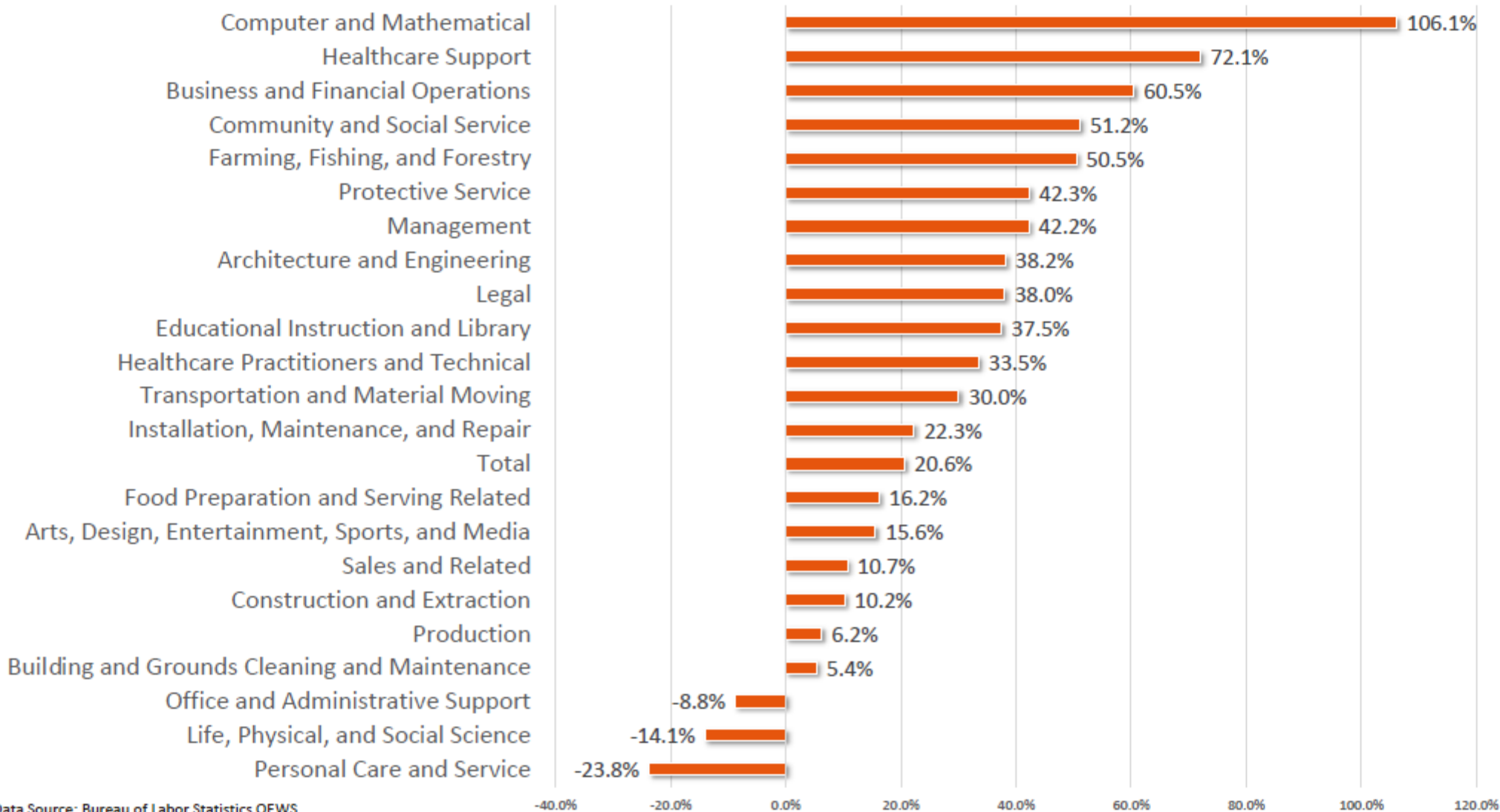
