UW-Madison Spring Commencement Saturday, May 8th

6,000 projected students for the 12pm ceremony - gates open at 10:30am.

1,500 to 2,000 projected students for the 4pm ceremony – gates open at 4:30pm.

Will know more accurate attendance figures after April 14th

Breese Terrace closed 6am to 8pm. Will open earlier if possible depending on event tear-down.

Requesting Metro reroute buses during this time period.

Will ask Traffic Enforcement to post no parking signage on Breese Terrace early in the week.

Will ask that Traffic Enforcement start to tow cars on Breese Terrace at 6am on Saturday, May 8th.

Will ask that Parking Utility bags the outbound meters on the 1400 block of Monroe Street for Saturday, May 8th. Inbound / south side of the street can remain unbagged and open.

Jersey barriers will be positioned similar to UW football games on Breese Terrace, but crowd control barricades will also be built to control access to the area surrounding Camp Randall. Green line on site layout show proposed locations for fencing. The far west side of Breese Terrace will have a solid line of fencing, with opening for access at the north / south / and west for graduates to access the stadium through Badger Badge check points.

All graduates attending the ceremony will have to show a green Badger Badge prior to entering the stadium perimeter.

Purpose of the street closure is to help maintain a safe environment for a large number of pedestrians and to provide proper space for physical distancing between attendees. Additionally, this closure helps to ensure that only those graduates with tickets gather outside the stadium.

Emergency vehicle access will be maintained at the north and south end of Breese Terrace.

Crowd control barricades will allow for Badger Badge check points to limit access and crowding outside the stadium, with ticketing being required for the event. Tickets will be scanned at the gates.

Working with a vendor for crowd control barrier placement and traffic control signage. Type 3 barricades at north and south end at Breese Terrace, Type 1 barricades on roads leading into Breese Terrace from Lathrop Street.

The west bound left turn lane from University to Breese Terrace will be closed for the day.


Police will staff the road closure from 8am to 6pm – with barricades up for set-up and tear down.

Residents will be allowed access to their property with showing ID's at the north and south vehicle check points, but during peak times before and after the ceremonies, vehicle traffic will not be permitted due to large crowd of pedestrians.

UW-Madison Community Relations will work to share event details with alders and neighborhood residents.
