| In 2022, the CDD issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) to identify a third-party consultant to help evaluate current services, engage community stakeholders, and craft strategies designed to help reach a more diverse population of older adults. The RFP was deemed unsuccessful because it elicited only a single response from an out-of-state firm with little experience with or exposure to Madison's community of older adults. EQT By Design is a skilled and experienced consultant in Madison that specializes in equity-centered community engagement, strategic planning, change management, and organizational culture design within government, community, and the corporate and nonprofit sectors. The services sought by the CDD require strong background and experience in elevating historically marginalized voices and perspectives to further equity-centered policy and systems change. EQT By Design has successfully performed services to gather, analyze and provide recommendations that helped build and implement strategic initiatives focused on equity-centered change for over 25 years.
