SUBJECT: June 18, 2013 Common Council Meeting: Committee of the Whole – Briefing & Discussion on 2014 Budget

The Finance Director, David Schmiedicke, will be providing an overview of current budget expenditures and anticipated revenue challenges we will likely be facing in 2014. The Committee of the Whole meeting will follow our regularly scheduled Common Council meeting on June 18, 2013. The meeting will begin with a "round" at which point Alders will be asked to talk about their goals and priorities for the 2014 budget.
