Dear Committee members,

As a longtime Sherman neighborhood resident, I can testify to the fact that drivers speeding on Loftsgordon Ave, Huxley St, and Schlimgen Ave have become more numerous and reckless in the past few years. Southbound drivers on Huxley accelerate from the stop sign at Schlimgen knowing it's clear sailing all the way to Aberg. By the time they crest the the hill at Spohn at 30-35 mph, it's too late to stop for pedestrians in the crosswalk. The stop signs should be moved from Spohn to Huxley, or perhaps changed to a four-way stop. Speeding is also a problem on Ruskin, part of which is a school zone. As the Oscar Mayer development proceeds, I'm concerned that these neighborhood streets will be used as alternatives to N Sherman Ave and Packers Ave. I hope you can find some workable solutions to this speeding problem.
