PROJECT STATUS

The geometry was approved by TC on May 26, 2021. The BPW approved the plans, specifications, and assessments on May 11, 2022 with recommendation of TC to review the ramp width at Regent Street.

ACTION

Proposed change of ramps across Regent Street from 5' width to 8' width. Staff recommends this change.

BACKGROUND

City Engineering is planning to replace the pavement on Braxton Place, construction of a new street La Mariposa Lane (Braxton Place to West Washington Avenue), and construction of a shared-use path (Braxton Place to Regent Street) in the Bayview neighborhood.

DESCRIPTION

Staff is recommending that the ramps across Regent Street at the shared-use path connection change from 5' width to 8' width to accommodate bicycles.

PUBLIC INPUT SUMMARY

There was no specific public outreach on this topic.

EQUITY & SUSTAINABILITY GOAL IMPACTS

Improving the ability of residents in the Bayview neighborhood to cross Regent Street to access the relocated bus stops near the new crossing.

FISCAL & PROCUREMENT IMPACTS

The plans will need to be adjusted, but the change should not make a meaningful change in construction cost.
