

The City of Madison is planning the Lower Badger Mill Creek Pond flood mitigation project for 2023. The project will provide regional stormwater storage on the far west side of Madison and will help reduce stormwater peak flow rates leaving the watershed. The project will also reduce inundation depths on adjacent properties during events up to the 1% annual chance storm. In order to achieve flood mitigation goals on site, the City will need to remove trees on Stormwater Utility owned property. The Stormwater Utility has worked with the City Forester and the City of Madison Streets Division to plan these tree removals and the plan for removing trees on this property will be considered by the Habitat Stewardship Subcommittee on Monday, November 7<sup>th</sup> at 4:30 P.M., via virtual meeting.
