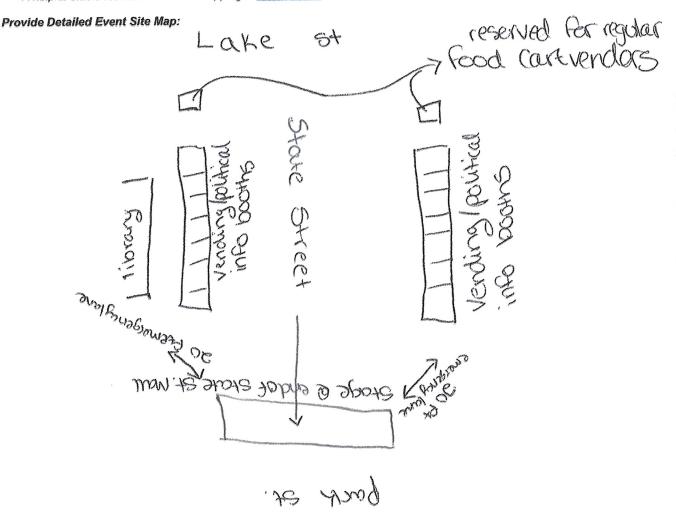

**GENERAL** 1.

#### Severe Weather C.

Weather forecasts and current conditions can be monitored through the National Weather 1. Service's Madison Weather Forecast website.

Before the event - If severe weather is predicted prior to the event, the EAP event representative 2. will evaluate the conditions and determine if the event will remain scheduled. The EAP event representative or his/her designee will be identified as such FIRST/LAST NAME and will be responsible to monitor the weather conditions before and during the event SWEWEW WILL During the event - If severe weather occurs during the event, the EAP event representative or

3. his/her designee FIRST/LAST NAME will make notification to those attending the event that a

hazardous weather condition exists and direct them to shelter.

There are very limited provisions for sheltering participants in the event of seven 4.

This event will follow the 30-30 Rule for lightning. If lightning is observed and bunder is heard 5. within 30 seconds, the event will be delayed until 30 minutes have passed since thunder was last heard.

#### D. **Fire**

- If a specific hazard has been identified as an increased risk of fire at this event, event manager 1. will work with the Fire Department to determine how to address the hazard.
- All event staff will be instructed on the safe use of Portable Fire Extinguishers. 2.
- If cooking is intended, you must contact the fire department and -
  - Must have a valid fire extinguisher, 2A10BC

- Each space is allowed 1 LP tank per cooking device. All LP tanks are to be secured in an b) approved manner (tied, strapped, chained, etc.)
- No cooking shall be allowed under a tent. Cooking shall be a minimum of 20' away from c) tents/canopies.
- Cooking must be on a non-combustible surface (grease collection material generally d) required under cooking and food service areas)
- Fire Inspectors may be required to do an inspection of your event (depends on size and nature of 4. the event), contact the Fire Department for guidelines
- All tents/canopies used for cooking shall have a FLAME SPREAD Certification attached to the 5.
- Should an incident occur that requires the Fire Department, 911 will be utilized to request this 6. resource. The caller should have the following information available to the 911 operator: nature of emergency, location, and contact person with callback number.

#### **Medical Emergencies** E.

- As with any outdoor event, there is potential for injury to the participants. The types of injuries are 1. various and include those that are heat related as well as traumatic injuries.
