RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act) (Public Law 116-136) was enacted by the United States Congress on March 27, 2020 and appropriated supplemental Public Housing Operating funding to Public Housing Authorities (PHAs); and

WHEREAS, the funds appropriated by Congress are to be used for eligible activities under the Operating Fund and the Capital Fund and according to Section 9 of the United States Housing Act of 1937 during the period the program is impacted by coronavirus, and other expenses related to preventing, preparing for, and responding to coronavirus; and

WHEREAS, the eligible use funds is outlined in the Public and Indian Housing Notice (PIH Notice) 2020-07, *Implementation of Supplemental Guidance to Federal Fiscal Year 2020 Operating Fund Appropriations*; and

WHEREAS, obligations of CARES Act Supplemental Operating Fund grant amounts are calculated based on each project's pro rata Calendar Year 2020 Operating Fund eligibility at the time HUD obligated funding; and

WHEREAS, the Community Development Authority of the City of Madison was allocated the following amounts per asset management project (Amp):

Amp 200 (East)	\$43,099
Amp 300 (West)	\$72,680
Amp 400 (Triangle)	\$48,122
Amp 500 (Truax 1)	\$19,513
Amp 600 (Truax 2)	\$11,939

For a total of \$195,353 for eligible activities to prevent, prepare for, and respond to coronavirus during the period beginning March 27, 2020 through December 31, 2020;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Community Development Authority Board of Commissioners authorizes the Community Development Authority to accept \$195,353 of Public Housing Operating Funds to prevent, prepare for, and respond to coronavirus.
