Established in 1985, AIDS Network provides integrated prevention and HIV care services to the communities of Dane County and southern Wisconsin with offices in Madison, Beloit and Janesville. Prevention services include HIV, Hepatitis C, and other testing, providing condoms and education, as well as clean syringe exchange to combat the spread of HIV and other infections. Direct care services for people living with HIV/AIDS include case management, linkage to medical care, a dental clinic, legal advocacy, food pantry, benefits counseling, emergency housing, and other essential programs. A core value of the agency is to provide these services directly and to collaborate with local partners to ensure needs are addressed.
