I'm writing in support of the Urban Land Interests' Pinckney Street proposal.

I first read about the proposal in the State Journal when they noted that city staff recommended not approving the removal of a historic building at that site. However, the historic building was already gutted in the 1970s, and the developers plan to retain the few original elements that remain. Such a tiny scrap of historic facade should not stand in the way of reasonable development, if the project meets other city needs.

According to the Journal, "to meet standards, for example, the proposed project must have substantial benefits to the general public that outweigh a strong public interest in preserving historic resources expressed in the preservation ordinance, and development could not happen in its current configuration without razing the landmark."

It's clear to me that thoughtful redevelopment far outweighs the marginal public interest in small historic details on an otherwise bland building. I hope you agree.
