








FIRST FLOOR PLAN 1/16" = 1'-0"

SQUARE FOOTAGE FIRST FLOOR = 3,299 SF








SECOND FLOOR PLAN 1/16" = 1'-0"








MEZZANINE PLAN 1/16" = 1'-0"
