## Capital Projects Monthly Report



2022 Capital Expenditures Status – As of April 30, 2022:

- Total: \$633,667 (increase of \$242,093 since March 31, 2022)
- Overview of April 2022 Capital Expenses:
  - 1. Pipelines: \$19,321
    - Lake Mendota Dr CIPP; New valves; WM replacement engineering/design
  - 2. Facilities: \$104,801
    - Well 26 repairs; Well 12 booster upgrade; Well 14 mitigation
  - 3. Fleet/Other: \$117,972
    - Hydrant program; Meters Purchased; VFD/MCC upgrades

Major Project Update: Well 19 Fe, Mn, Radium Treatment Facility

- Project Budget: \$9,088,000 (2022 Budget: \$891,000)

  - 2. Design Contract (SEH, Inc.): \$780,000
    - Design Kickoff on 5/24/2022; Introduce project, roles, site visits
  - 3. Preliminary Design Activities:
    - Scope review; Design criteria; Site evaluation with UW Facilities;

#### **Major Project Update: Well 15 PFAS Treatment Facility**

- Project Budget: \$5,943,000 (2022 Budget: \$425,000)
  - 1. Status to-date:
    - Contract with AECOM has been executed and is proceeding
    - Public Info Meeting/Listening Session scheduled for 6/30 (6:30-8:00 PM, East Madison Community Center)
  - 2. Design Contract (AECOM): \$336,764 (NTE \$375,000)
    - Kickoff meeting on 6/1 Introduce project team, review scope: benchscale pilot testing, alternatives analysis & preliminary design
    - Data work in-progress; Sample collection in July for lab pilot testing
