SUMMARY:

Bill Fruhling, Planning Division, was in attendance to explain the resolution directing staff to prepare a plan for State Street and Capitol Square and other immediately adjacent areas to address the residential developments, restaurants and retail, transportation plans, and other recent and upcoming changes.
