WHEREAS, on September 14, 2016, the Transit and Parking Commission held a public hearing regarding proposed Parking Utility rate changes for the lower level of the State Street Capitol Garage and special event parking; and

WHEREAS, the Transit and Parking Commission referred the special event rate change proposal back to the Transit and Parking Commission Subcommittee for further review and discussion: and

WHEREAS, the Transit and Parking Commission Subcommittee met on November 21, 2016 and recommended that a proposal to increase the pay-on-entry special event fee at all Parking Utility facilities from the current rate of \$5.00 to a rate of \$8.00, be brought to the Transit and Parking Commission for consideration; and

WHEREAS, the Transit and Parking Commission Subcommittee recommended a proposed effective date of January 15, 2017 for the proposed special event rate change; and

WHEREAS, a change in the special event parking fee will impact availability of on-street parking supporting State Street retailers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the pay-on-entry special event fee for all Parking Utility facilities shall be \$8.00, effective January 15, 2017; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Transit and Parking Commission will bring forward a proposal for increased hours of enforcement for on-street parking within two blocks of State Street, with an intent to have such change in place by September 2017.

- Cashiered parking rates calculated in half-hour increments; 20-minute grace period
- The Evening/Weekend Maximum rate applies to cashiered parking during the following time periods:
- Hours parked after 6 p.m. weeknights (until 5 a.m. the following day); and
- Hours parked on Saturdays/Sundays (from 5 a.m. until 5 a.m. the following day)

Parking garages can be used free of charge between 9 p.m. and 7 a.m. on days when a snow emergency has been declared.

Coupons: Businesses and individuals can request coupons for distribution to customers/clients.

We invoice for the value of redeemed coupons plus a 10% admin fee.

- (b) All garages and surface lots are enforced 24/7.
- (c) Rate changes for special event parking will be considered separately from this rate schedule in conjunction with potential changes to on-street enforcement hours, as requested at the 2.8.16 TPC Subcommittee Mtg.
- (d) On-street meters are enforced in general from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. UW meters in this area are enforced 8 a.m. to 9 p.m.
- (e) Eligible carpoolers and electric car drivers qualify for the (discounted) Monthly Resident rate and are entitled to immediate occupancy in select facilities,
- (f) Parkers and the Utility are required to provide 30-days notice to terminate monthly parking agreements.
- (g) Regular Monthly Limited Hours, Monday Friday

Night Permit - (Created in 2014) Valid 7 days a week from 6 p.m. to 7 a.m.
