Wisconsin State Department of Transportation Presentation: Beltline Planning & Environmental Linkages Study

WisDOT is starting a Planning and Environmental Linkages (PEL) study to investigate possible solutions to existing and future congestion, safety and mobility problems on the Madison Beltline, and identify potential solutions. Possible solutions could include capacity expansion of the Beltline and interchanges, improvements to other area roadways, construction of new roadways in the surrounding area and improvements to other modes of travel. The project encompasses the entire Beltline between USH 14 in Middleton and CTH N near Deerfield.
