WELCOME

Your commitment and service to Madison Public Library is greatly appreciated. I have been working with library staff to bring better organization to our onboarding process and to provide you with a background on MPL and your duties as a board member. We hope to continue this beyond the onboarding stage and introduce more updates to the entire board. It will be done in conjunction with an onboarding process being developed for new alders. We hope to include videos that highlight the purpose and vision of MPL at a later date. So for now, welcome aboard the MPL team.

IN DEDICATION TO

As I shared in a post to the Library Board, it is with extreme sadness to report the passing of Barb Dimick, long time MPL Library Director of 17 years, and leader for youth services for a combined over 30 years of service to MPL and the Madison community. She was responsible for a number of building projects most notably the renovation of Central Library. I applaud her accomplishments and forever remain thankful for the solid foundation she left MPL to continue to build upon. The MPL Staff Association and Library Management recognized her leadership and many contributions by contributing to a fund to plant trees in her honor. Barb's family will be working with our Foundation to determine a suitable way to recognize her that is yet to be determined.

PUBLIC HEALTH

Dane County is now at a Medium COVID-19 Community Level (Community Level has been shifting between Medium and High, which was expected by Public Health). The most important message I have been sharing with staff and I share with you is to be sure to get the new bivalent booster if you are already current with your other shots. In addition it is important to get your flu shot. They can both be given at the same appointment.

BUDGET 2023

The Mayor's 2023 Executive Operating Budget will be released Oct 6, 2022. We did not incur any amendments to the 2023 Executive Capital Budget, which is always a good sign. I will be presenting to the Finance Committee on Oct 17th on our operating budget. There will be a short period after that date for Finance Committee to introduce any amendments to the Executive budget. Ending with the final Adoption of the 2023 Budget meetings by Common Council beginning on November 15th. [Then we get to begin to work on our 2024 budget.]

IMAGINATION CENTER (BP)

Schematic design continues on the facilities and grounds for the Imagination Center. We have started the process of bring in more MPL staff to help inform the project. We have also discussed a major realignment of the facility to save additional trees that will also enhance the function of the building. Operating in conjunction with the schematic design is the Parks work on their Master Plan for Reindahl

Park. The Master Plan is more global in its scope covering how the entire park space will function, but it will include the Imagination Center.

MPL FOUNDATION UPDATE

It is with mixed feelings that I report the departure of Jenni Jeffress as the Executive Director of the MPL Foundation. It is huge loss, and we will miss her expertise and passion for supporting MPL through the Foundation. She has been with the Foundation since 2010, and in those 12 years she has grown the Foundation and raises millions of dollars. When I arrived in 2012, the Foundation was giving the library on an annual basis from \$25K to \$30K. That gift has grown to be in the hundreds of thousands on an annual basis. All of this in addition to the millions raised to support our building projects. I said it was with mixed feeling because I am also delighted that she has this tremendous opportunity to remain in Madison and lead the Rennebohm Foundation. This appointment affirms how talented she is with her philanthropic expertise. We wish her all the best in her new journey.

WEST SIDE COMMUNITY ANALYSIS (WS)

In the August report Rynn Kerkhove had been finalizing a new version of Tell Us packets to begin distribution to the neighborhood libraries. That task was accomplished and she has started to work with library staff to begin to collect community input. She has been working with Ariel Robinson at Meadowridge and she will be hosting a Tell Us engagement conversation with residents from that neighborhood the evening of October 10th. She will be hosting a table at the Westside Community Market every Saturday morning through the end of the season starting October 8th.

Rynn continues to reach out to other organizations and neighborhood associations to schedule presentations in the coming weeks. She will also be attending the Catholic Multicultural Center Hispanic Heritage event with Tammy Ocampo to promote the Tell Us project.

WISCONSIN BOOK FESTIVAL

A reminder and an invitation to the Library Board that our annual Wisconsin Book Festival is coming up from Oct 13-16. Although we host programs throughout the year these dates represent full days of authors and several events at Central Library. The festival was preceded by some amazing events including an overflow crowd of over 400 in attendance for the new David Maraniss book, and an equally exciting and well attended presentation by Jason Mott, winner of the 2021 National Book Award for Fiction.

Spoiler alert: We have an exceptional closing event to the festival on Sunday with Cody Keenan, President Obama's speechwriter, who will be joined by Pete Souza, the White House official photographer during the Obama presidency. A can't miss opportunity to hear about the many stories during their assignment to these two important roles for the Obama administration.
