



2024 Thurber Park Artist-in-Residence Application

The City of Madison and The Bubbler at Madison Public Library offer an exciting opportunity for an artist residency in the Thurber Park Art Studio. The artist will have access to a free studio space (including utilities but no WIFI) for 11-months, with the opportunity to extend the residency for another 12-months. The artist will receive a \$7,500 stipend per year. The artist is responsible for acquiring a business insurance policy.

- Applications reviewed by MAC Public Art Committee: March 11, 2024
- MAC votes: March 12, 2024
- Finalist Presentations (if requested by MAC): April 3, 2024
- Applicants notified of decision: May, 2024
- Residency: Anticipated for Oct 1, 2024 to August 31, 2025 (opportunity to renew until August 31, 2026)

ELIGIBILITY

- Single artist or artist pair

- Must reside in Madison for the duration of the residency
- Must have experience hosting art outreach events
- Must work in an artistic medium that is safe to use within the studio and is appropriate for a residential area
- Must demonstrate the ability to produce a permanent outdoor public artwork

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

The Artist-in-Residence will work closely with The Bubbler at Madison Public Library to engage the local community through open studio days, community workshops, or other strategies determined by the artist in coordination with residency administrators.

PUBLIC ART COMMISSION

Artists who produce work that is suitable for outdoor display in adverse weather conditions – high winds, rain, intense heat, snow, and freezing temperatures – are prioritized for this residency. The artist may be commissioned to create a public artwork for the City of Madison. The location and budget will be determined in consultation with staff, and this opportunity is not guaranteed. Artists are welcome and encouraged to work with fabricators as needed for the production of the resulting work.
