3. Overview of Organization

Black Men Coalition of Dane County Youth Baseball (BMCDC-YB), an organization founded in 2022, is committed to revitalizing the game of baseball within the Dane County community. BMCDC-YB seeks to level the playing field by providing a free youth baseball program where registration, equipment and travel are provided at no cost at all to participants. BMCDC-YB operates under the thought that baseball teaches a skill set that is different from any other sport and provide mentorship that teaches youth the mindset needed to overcome obstacles and to be resilient in the face of adversity. Along with mentorship and physical activity, the program will provide youth from all genders, races and socio-economic backgrounds between the ages of 5 and 12 in underserved communities with free positive recreational activities and mentorship. Coaches will teach technical skills along with core values such as sportsmanship, teamwork, leadership and doing one's best while also having fun.

This is a brand new youth program focuses on access and inclusivity while providing positive recreational and developmental activities in Madison Parks, making it well qualified for a pilot fee modification. The Parks Division and City of Madison share these same goals and are interested ensuring the program's success. BMCDC-YB and the Parks Division agree to the following fee modification conditions:

4. Term of Fee Modification (May only be for a period of up to three years)

Agreement shall begin upon signing and terminating on September 1, 2022

5. Summary of Requested Use of Park Land

BMCDC-YB will utilize various softball diamonds at Elver Park that are not already programmed for other uses for Skills camp on June 4 & 5, practices Monday-Friday June 6-August 26 (4PM-8PM), games on Saturdays and Sundays between June 25- August 26 (10AM-8PM), and tournament games on August 27 & 28 (10AM-8PM). Elver #4 will be the primary field used by BMCDC-YB throughout the season, and other fields may be used when they are available and have been properly reserved. BMCDC-YB also desires to use Bowman Baseball if available for older youth during the tournament weekend August 27& 28. BMCDC-YB may use the concessions building during skills camp, games and tournament.



6. Reason for Considering to Authorize a Fee Modification (check box that applies)

7. Fee Modification Proposed (Include Use, Permit and all other fees)

BMCDC-YB will pay standard youth rate for games and tournaments, but will not pay fees for practices and skills camp. BMCDC-YB will pay concession rental, vending fees and lighting fees per standard rate. Fees will be due within two weeks of the final reservation date.

10. Roles/Responsibilities of Organization/Individual (Conditions of Approval)

- 1. Submit specific date and time reservation requests for use of the location by June 1
- 2. Keep field in neat and orderly manner. Remove trash from field and place in trashcans, place coals from grilling in designated barrels.
- 3. Chalk fields between games if desired
- 4. Purchase temporary mound and outfield fence
- 5. Place and remove temporary mound and outfield fence following each use
- 6. Clean and lock concessions when leaving, remove food and other belongings at end of each use, unless prior approval has been received.
- 7. Grills are to be used in designated locations, used Charcoal must be placed in designated receptacles
- 8. Signs may be allowed during reservations, but must be removed when BMCDC-YB is not occupying the space.
- 9. Call rainout line and/or check Online Reservation System to determine if field is open or closed.
- 10. Provide approved storage bin(s) in agreed upon location(s)
- 11. Provide light schedule to Parks Staff and designate representative each night to communicate changes to lighting needs to MUSCO.
- 12. Provide port-a-johns at field, if desired. Location must be approved by Parks prior to placement

11. Roles/Responsibilities of Parks Division

1. Reserve fields

- 2. Perform regular mowing and field maintenance schedules
- 3. Provide diamond prep for skills camp, games and tournament, once per day consisting of dragging and lining field.
 - Parks will not provide field prep between games on same day.
- 4. Install base pegs at appropriate distance for youth league on diamonds 3 & 4
- 5. Update rainout line and GymDandy.
- 6. Provide bases that will be stored onsite in a closed storage container.
 - Remove maintenance equipment from concessions area prior to weekend use.
- 7. Provide keys to access field, concessions, restroom, and onsite storage.
- 8. Provide trash cans and charcoal receptacles
- 9. Provide BMCDC-YB light schedule report and authorize MABL to communicate changes with MUSCO
- 10. Update rainout line and online reservation system



12. Damage

If Madison Parks or BMCDC-YB identify damage at the fields, the parties will work together to identify the cause of the damage and a plan for repair. Damage caused by the BMCDC-YB, beyond normal wear and tear, will be the responsibility of the BMCDC-YB to repair or pay Madison Parks to repair.
