Our Mission

We are a group of Nakoma Residents partnering with the city and community organizations who wish to enhance Nakoma Park as a recreational destination for everyone. It's our overall goal to improve the park for year round enjoyment, while respecting the natural beauty of our unique location in the city.

Background

The City of Madison Park Department has allocated \$75,000 to make park improvements in Nakoma Park in the 2013 budget. The Parks Department will replace the playground equipment and improve surfacing within Nakoma Park. The city plans to begin this project in June and have it completed by the end of the summer.

A group of community members living near the park met with the city in early April 2013. During that meeting we learned that of the \$75,000, two thirds of the budget is for site demolition and preparation. One third is for purchase of one multi-use play structure and one swing set.

We began wondering if it would be possible to raise funds independently to enhance the city's allowance for playground equipment. It has been evident from these discussions that there is desire in the community to both assist with this current project and to contribute to future improvements to our community park.

Our Goals

To raise \$25,000 by July 4 of this year for additional play structure equipment.

In the future, the committee wishes to collaborate with the City of Madison Parks Department for further enhancements of the park within the limits of the Madison Parks Department Master Plan.
