Living at our current address on Maher Avenue between Pflaum Rd and Buckeye for 19 years, we've seen some changes and updates to Turner and Camden.

After a couple accidents a while back at Ruth and Maher, where vehicles ended up in yards of families with small children right in the middle of the day, we finally got some Yield signs installed on Ruth.

We totally understand the need to put speed bumps on Camden and stop signs on Turner. It's not surprising Spaanem is experiencing an increase in speeders, thus the recommendation for Stop signs. But don't forget Maher Avenue which has speeders, too.

As residents on Maher Avenue all these years, we strongly encourage you to include Maher Avenue in the current plan for Stop signs at the same time. Since there is no Stop sign from Pflaum to Allis, they speed past our house, even with the Stop sign at Allis at the end of our block.

We already have speeders, going in both directions, and it will only get worse if Maher Avenue is the only one of the four streets with nothing to slow traffic. Please complete the installation of both streets together, so speeders will hopefully get the hint you cannot use our neighborhood as a "speed cut-through".

Please help keep our Maher Avenue families just as safe as those families on Spaanem.
