2021 Operational Goals and Financial Condition Amount allocated: \$105,000

- Dane Dances \$25,000 \$10,000
- Make Music Madison \$30,000 **\$10,000**
- Between the Waves Songwriting Conference \$25,000 \$0
- Fairs/Festivals/Summer Concerts \$15,000 \$15,000
- Blink + (Temporary Public Art for Downtown Doors, and other locations) \$30,000 - \$25,000
- Music Tourism Economic Recovery Plan \$45,000

Strategize for Equity







Figure 1. Dane County Music Ecosystem Economic Impact, Output, Compensation, GVA (Million USD) and Employment 2018





Indirect Impact Output Breakdown, 2018





Annual Average Income by Race





Distribution of Music Assets by Category in Madison




