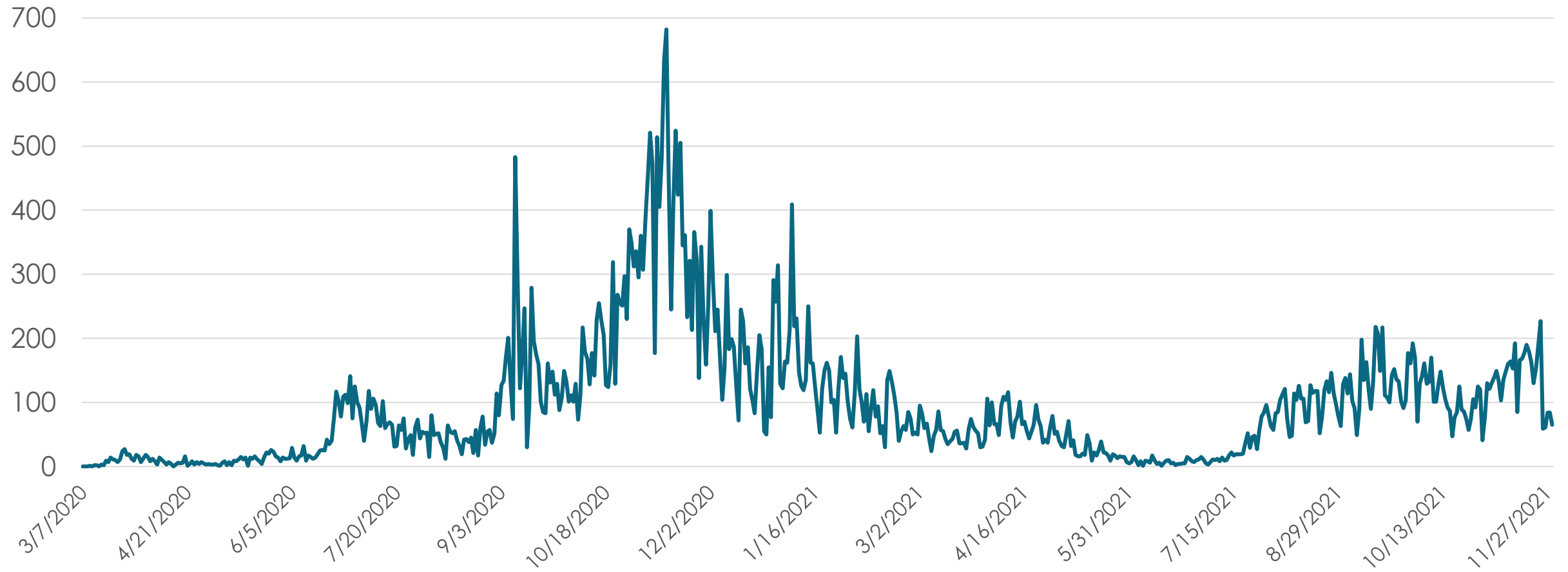

60,400+ people have tested positive for COVID.

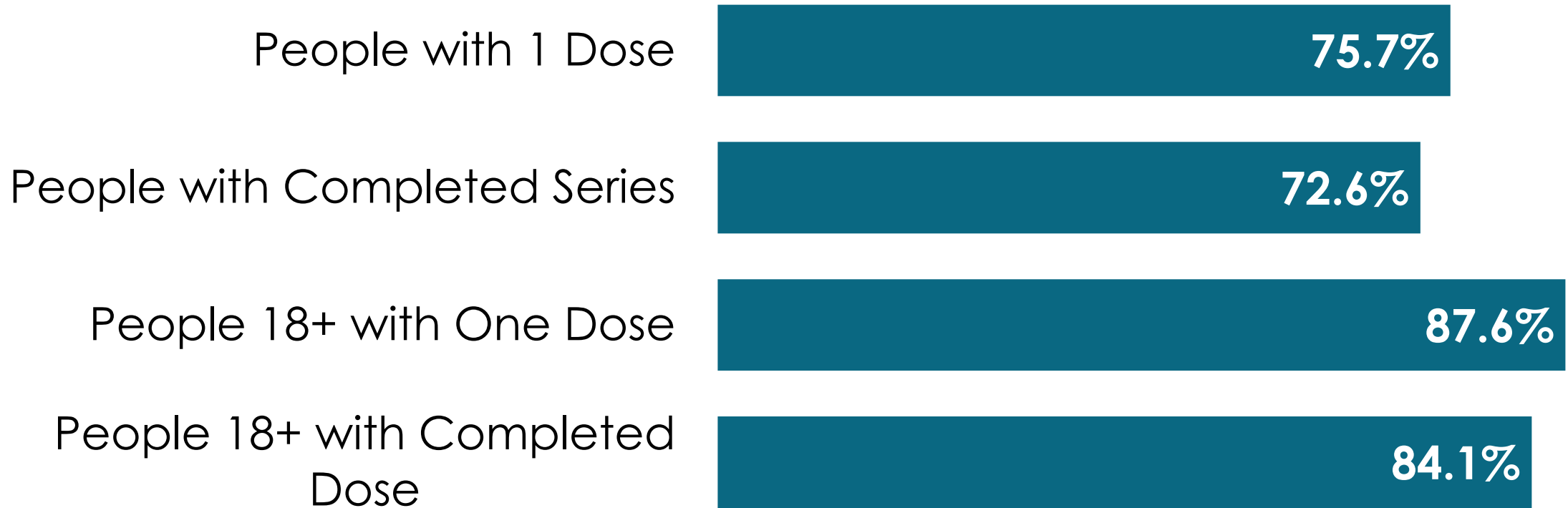

COVID-19 Vaccine



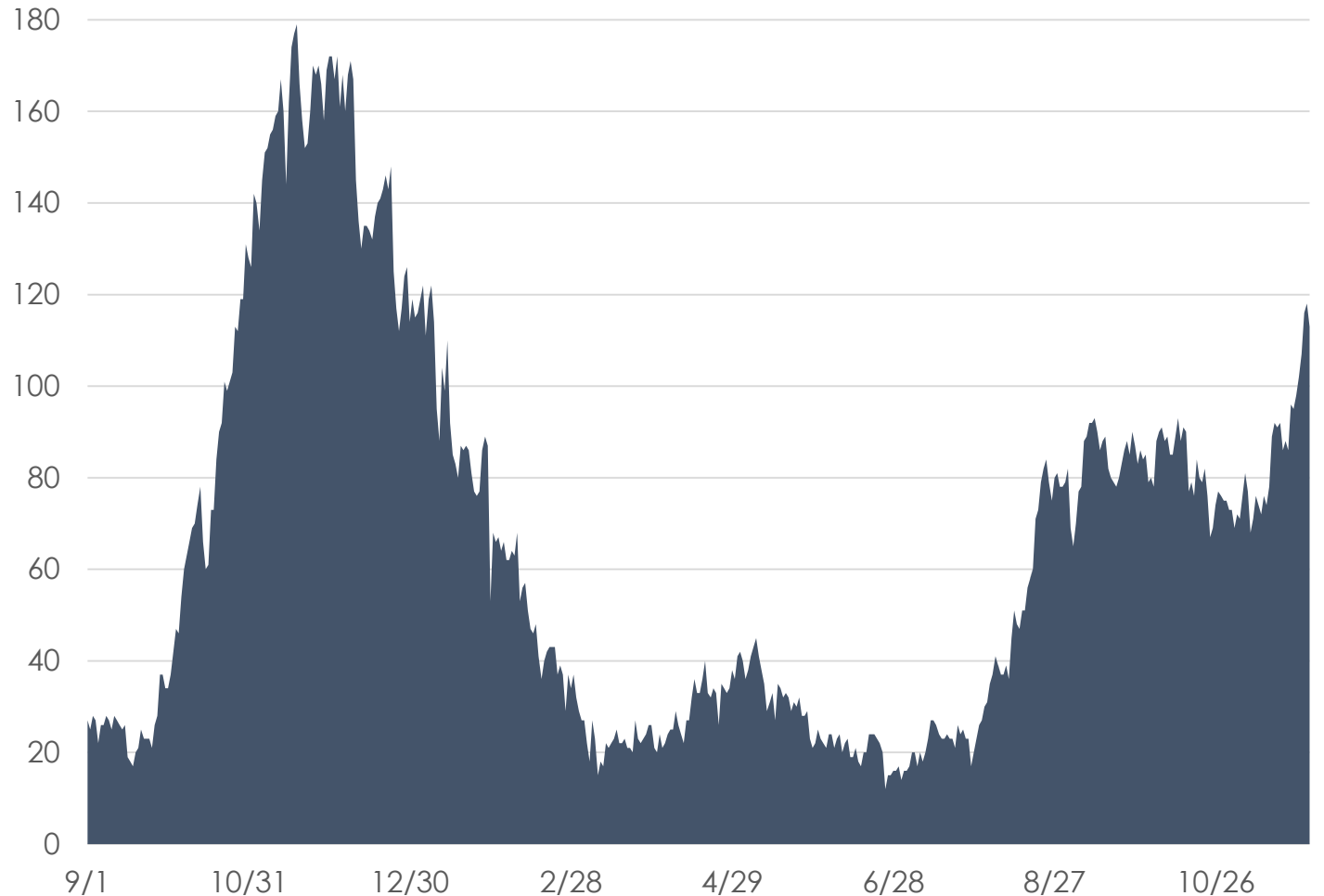

received a booster or third dose

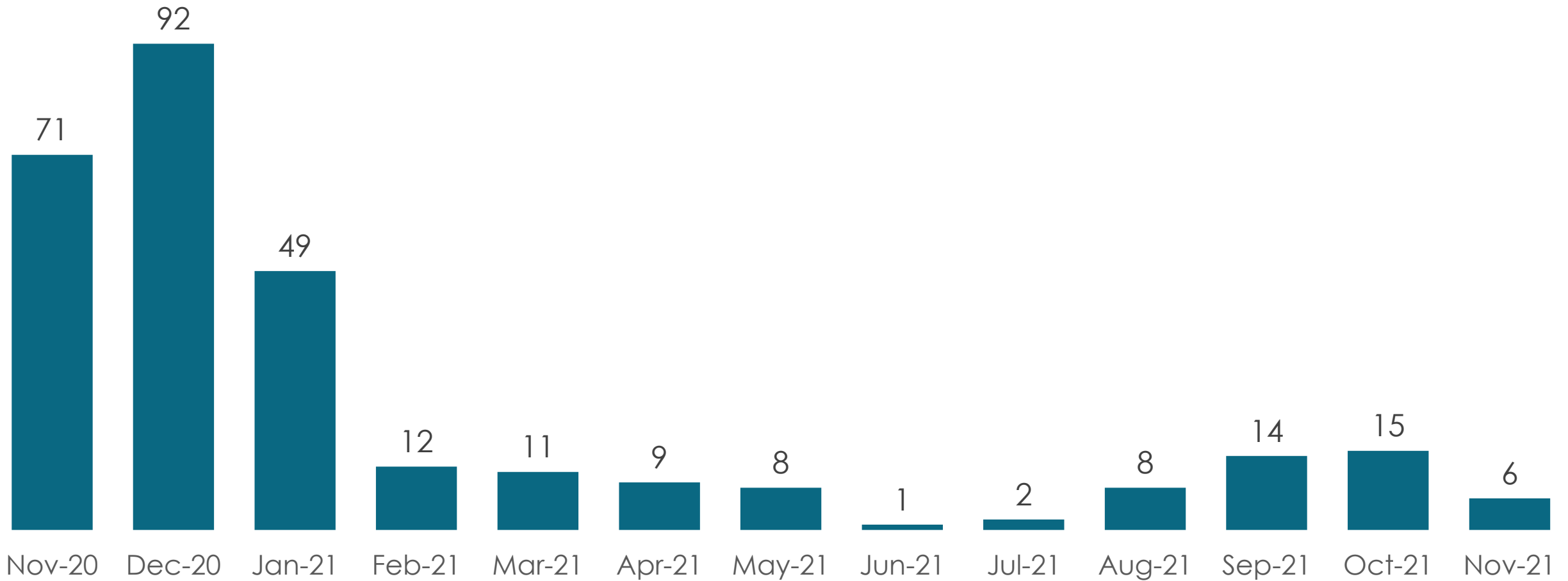
Hospitalizations

Hospitalizations are increasing but are still below where they were in late fall 2020.

Arena Mass Vaccination Clinic

Since the Arena opened on October 12:

- **6,511** primary and booster doses
- **4,186** doses for ages 5-11



Current Testing Volume & Capacity

Testing volume:

3,400 tests/day

Testing capacity:

4,500 tests/day

(including 36 partner testing locations, plus our South Madison Office)



Spotlight: Housing and Homelessness

- Current outbreak happening among people connected to shelters
- 53 people testing positive
- IQC providing isolation, quarantine, and testing

Omicron Variant

- Continuing to promote vaccination and boosters as a protective factor
- We are concerned, but not panicked
- Scientists still learning more about Omicron transmissibility, symptoms, and immune evasion, and it will take some time before we have answers



Omicron Variant

- UW-Madison and WSLH monitoring sequences for VOC (variants of concern), and UW is increasing the number of samples they sequence as a result of Omicron
- Our partnerships will allow us to know quickly when Omicron is detected in Dane County
