


Certificate of Appropriateness for 909-915 Jenifer

 Combination of the lot for 909 Jenifer and the lot for 911-915 Jenifer to create a single parcel







History of the Property


- Block originally had mostly double parcels, which typically evolved to have two principal structures
- Lots divided and combined in different configurations over time
- Originally each lot was a part of separate double-wide parcels














Applicable Standards

41.18(4) <u>Land Divisions and Combinations</u>. The <u>commission shall approve</u> a certificate of appropriateness for land divisions, combinations, and subdivision plats of landmark sites and properties in historic districts, <u>unless</u> it finds that the proposed lot sizes adversely impact the historic character or significance of a landmark, are incompatible with adjacent lot sizes, or fail to maintain the general lot size pattern of the historic district.





Staff Recommendation

Staff believes that the standards for granting a Certificate of Appropriateness are met and recommends that the Landmarks Commission approve the project as proposed.
