The Developer, VAL, LLC, is requesting approval for a private developer agreement with the City to construct Phase 15 at Village at Autumn Lake. The includes agreements and the construction of public improvements to serve 31 lots which are part of Village at Autumn Lake Replat and the proposed Village at Autumn Lake Replat No 8. Work shall include the construction of watermain, storm sewer, and sanitary sewer. Water and sanitary sewer to serve this portion of the development shall be built from existing on Felland Road at the intersection with Tranquility Trail towards the south to the intersection with Woodbine Drive. In addition to sidewalk improvements on phase interior streets, the developer shall construction sidewalk on the east side of Felland Road from Woodbine Drive to match existing at Tranquility Drive. Four trees in City right of way along Felland Road as required due to damage from construction operations. The agreement shall also include pavement marking, street signing, and streetlights as required by Traffic Engineering. Contract 9378 shall include all public improvements except for asphalt surface paving which will be included in Contract 9385.

The Wisconsin Historical Society and the State of Wisconsin Department of Administration (as the Developer) have received conditional approval from the City of Madison to demolish the existing Wisconsin History Museum and adjacent acquired buildings located at 18-30 N Carroll Street. These properties are to be combined by Certified Survey Map and redeveloped into the proposed Wisconsin History Center. The Developer will perform demolition in the public right-of-way (including removing 7 street terrace trees in the N Carroll Street and 14 street terrace trees in W Mifflin Street) to facilitate the construction of the redevelopment, install an Earth Retention System (ERS) required for the private excavation, and install new private service laterals. Final restoration of the N Carroll Street, W Mifflin Street, and State Street right-of-way disturbed by the redevelopment will be restored by the City of Madison under a separate public works project. The Developer will provided a deposit as a condition of approval for the redevelopment to cover the Developer's share of the restoration that will be completed by the City of Madison.

As part of the Acacia Ridge Phase 10 there are improvements required on Valley View Road adjacent to the Acacia Ridge Subdivision. The City share of these improvements is estimated at \$172,500.00 and in order to offset the cost of improvements constructed by the Developer on behalf of the City it was agreed to have the City surface pave the previously constructed streets in Acacia Ridge Phases 6, 7, and 9. To allow this change in scope of work between the Developer and the City addendums to the associated surface paving contracts are required (contracts 9041, 9071, and 9261).
