The developer, Dane County Administration, Dept. of Public Works, has received approval for a two-lot Certified Survey Map (CSM). The CSM will include one lot in Suburban Employment District zoning and one lot/outlot in Agricultural District zoning at 8603-8901 Femrite Drive. The developer shall be responsible for the construction of sanitary sewer, storm sewer and water main to serve the lots. These utilities are being constructed from connections to the south of the project. The developer shall also be responsible for street improvements including sidewalk and curb and gutter along the southern portion of Luds Lane from Existing CTH AB (E Buckeye Road) to the temporary turnaround east of proposed Lot 1; curb and gutter along the northern portion of Luds Lane from Future CTH AB to the temporary turn around. This project shall service the County's East District Campus and as well as the proposed Public Safety Communication Center to be built south of Luds Lane and East of future CTH AB. The Public Safety Communication Center project is proposed for Lot 1 of the CSM and is moving through a separate site plan approval process.

Parks is seeking to replace the existing playground equipment at (4) parks: Garner, Manchester, Meadowood, and Sherwood Forest. The new, proposed equipment will meet current safety standards and offer increased accessibility. Parks has an established budget per replacement based on the park's classification level (mini-park, neighborhood park, and community park). The classification system follows the National Recreation and Park Association guidelines. Staff work with area residents in designing a unique playground for their park that meets the allocated budget. The intent is to offer distinct play equipment by park while providing a consistent level of service per the park's classification. Total estimated cost is \$480,000.

20 is Plenty is a city-wide initiative to help promote slower speeds on local streets. This project is for Citywide sign modifications to reduce local/residential-classified streets from 25 mph speed limit to 20 mph speed limit. The focus of new and replacement 20 mph signs will be primarily on streets entering neighborhoods and not necessarily posting on all streets within a neighborhood. It is expected that collected and arterial streets with speed limits of 25 mph would remain as such. This project includes approximately 1,900 new signs across the City. Estimated Cost: \$498,212.00.

This project will remove two old, corroding seawalls along the Yahara River shoreline. Once the seawalls are removed in these areas, they will be restored with riprap to protect the shoreline. Along with the seawall replacement, a path is being added from the existing sidewalk to the river where stone steps will be added for access to the river in this area. Once the shoreline improvements are complete, any areas disturbed during construction will be restored, seeded and matted. Total estimated cost is \$210,000.00.
