This project is to reconstruct and rehabilitate paver tiles on grade along the Olin Terrace Walkway at the Monona Terrace Community & Convention Center located at 1 John Nolen Drive. Work will consist of removal and recycling existing paver tiles, recondition sand base coarse and replace paver tiles with new tiles provided by Monona Terrace. Estimated cost is \$57,000.

The new prefabricated bridge will be installed using a crane and the approaches on both sides will be repaved. Estimated cost is \$100,000.
