This Project will treat 189.1 acres of previously under treated stormwater draining from the existing East Towne Commercial Area. These improvements consist of a northeast engineered wet detention cell and a northwest wet cell designed to reduce peak flow, sediment and phosphorus prior to entering Starkweather Creek and ultimately to Lake Monona. Along with the detention improvement, there will be some stormsewer updates to help reduce garbage and floatables prior to entering the stormwater system. Estimated cost is \$1,100,600.00
