# **Public Art Updates**

## **Atwood Avenue Percent for Art Plan**

Multiple locations on Atwood Ave, District 15



- Poetry in Sidewalks by 2022 Youth Poet Laureate Madeleine Bohn and Poet Laureate Angie Trudell Vasquez is completed.
- Three Utility Boxes wraps by Rachel Durfee and Chris Murphy are in progress.
- Path medallions designed by Daniella Echeverria are expected to be installed in Spring, 2024.

# Bartillon Shelter Percent for Art Plan – Lilian Sizemore

1904 Bartillon Dr, District 12



- Madison Arts and Engineering staff have entered into preliminary conversations with artist Lillian Sizemore to act as a landscape and public art consultant for the exterior site plan.
- Sizemore would work to integrate public art into proposed sites. We will contract her for an initial public art plan that would then be reviewed by other staff and MAC.
- We anticipate we will also run a call for existing artwork to license or purchase for additional interior and/or exterior sites.

## **Darbo-Worthington Sculpture – Austen Brantley**

Starkweather Creek Bike Path at E Washington Avenue, District 12







- The artist has identified a site in the public right of way along E Washington and the Bike Path at the entrance to the Darbo Worthington neighborhood.
- Staff are awaiting updated designs from the artist to incorporate into the survey, along with a Certificate of Insurance to proceed with his agreement.
- The survey is drafted and will be distributed to neighborhood residents & stakeholders.
- Anticipated production and installation will be 2024.

# **Imagination Center at Reindahl Park Percent for Art Plan**

- Staff from The Bubbler and Madison Arts are partnering on the public art plan.
- In consultation with Parks, Engineering, and Library staff we have identified potential sites.
- In Spring, 2024 we anticipate launching an RFQ for a priority site that is suitable for a large outdoor sculpture.
- We intend to transfer Percent for Art funds from the Metro Transit Hansen Road facility to bolster the budget of this project.

#### **West Area and North East Area Plans**


- Madison Arts staff are working with colleagues in the Planning Division to host arts workshops in conjunction with both the West Area and North East Area Plans.

Warner Park, 1625 Northport, District 12




- Metal and granite surfaces of the sculpture were restored and polished.
