DRAFTER'S ANALYSIS: Unused balances in the debt service fund (general debt reserves) can result from underspending in debt-financed capital projects and from receipt of bond sale premiums. These balances do not represent on-going revenue sources for city expenditures. Application of these balances in support of ongoing city spending could create future structural budget deficits, compromising provision of city services. This ordinance would prohibit the use of this one-time revenue source for on-going expenditures by requiring that use of general debt reserves be matched by an equal amount of expenditures on capital projects.
