RE: Approval of a conditional use for an addition within 200 feet of a public park at 101-103 Dempsey Road.

Dear Mr. Thompson:

At its June 17, 2013 meeting, the Plan Commission found the standards met and **approved** your client's conditional use application for 101-103 Dempsey Road, subject to the conditions below. In order to receive final approval of the conditional use, and for any necessary permits to be issued for your project, the following conditions shall be met:

Please contact Janet Dailey of the City Engineering Division at 261-9688 if you have questions regarding the following 2 items:

- 1. The Applicant shall submit, prior to plan sign-off, a digital CAD file (single file) to the Engineering Program Specialist in the Engineering Division (Lori Zenchenko). The digital CAD file shall be to scale and represent final construction. The single CAD file submittal can be either AutoCAD (dwg) Version 2001 or older, MicroStation (dgn) Version J or older, or Universal (dxf) format and contain only the following data, each on a separate layer name/level number.
 - a) Building Footprints
 - b) Internal Walkway Areas
 - c) Internal Site Parking Areas
 - d) Other Miscellaneous Impervious Areas (i.e. gravel, crushed stone, bituminous/asphalt, concrete, etc.)
 - e) Right-of-Way lines (public and private)
 - f) All Underlying Lot lines or parcel lines if unplatted
 - g) Lot numbers or the words "unplatted"
 - h) Lot/Plat dimensions
 - i) Street names

All other levels (contours, elevations, etc) are not to be included with this file submittal.

NOTE: Email file transmissions preferred lzenchenko@cityofmadison.com. Include the site address in the subject line of this transmittal. Any changes or additions to the location of the building, sidewalks, parking/pavement during construction will require a new CAD file. (POLICY and MGO 37.09(2) & 37.05(4))

2. The applicant shall submit, prior to plan sign-off, digital PDF files to the Engineering Division (Jeff Benedict or Tim Troester). The digital copies shall be to scale, and shall have a scale bar on the plan set. (POLICY and MGO 37.09(2)).

PDF submittals shall contain the following information:

- a) Building footprints
- b) Internal walkway areas
- c) Internal site parking areas
- d) Lot lines and right-of-way lines
- e) Street names
- f) Stormwater Management Facilities
- g) Detail drawings associated with Stormwater Management Facilities (including if applicable planting plans

Please contact Pat Anderson of the Zoning Office at 266-5978 if you have any questions regarding the following 5 items:

- 3. Bike parking shall comply with MGO Table 28I-3 (General Regulations). Provide a minimum of two (2) bike parking stalls. Bicycle parking design and location shall comply with MGO Sec. 28.141(11). Provide details on final plans. A bike-parking stall is two feet by six feet with a five-foot access area.
- 4. Signage approvals are not granted by the Plan Commission. Signage must be reviewed for compliance with MGO Chapter 31 (Sign Codes) prior to sign installations.
- 5. Pursuant to MGO Sec. 28.142(3) Landscape Plan and Design Standards: Landscape plans for zoning lots greater than the thousand (10,000) square feet in size must be prepared by a registered landscape architect.
- 6. Provide details of dumpster enclosure on final plans.
- 7. Pursuant to MGO Section 28.14(4)(e) Parking requirements for persons with Disabilities. The provisions contained in Wis. Stat. 101.12,346.503, and 346.56 and any related Wisconsin Administrative Code sections are hereby adopted by reference and made applicable to all parking facilities whenever constructed.

8. Madison Fire Department does not object to this proposal provided the project complies with all applicable fire codes and ordinances.

Please contact Eric Halvorson, Traffic Engineering at 266-6572 if you have any questions regarding the following two items:

- 9. When the applicant shall submit plans for approval, the applicant shall show the following: items in the terrace as existing (e.g., signs and street light poles), type of surfaces, existing and proposed property lines, addresses, one contiguous plan (showing all easements, all pavement markings, building placement, and stalls), adjacent driveway approaches to lots on either side and across the street, signage, percent of slope, semitrailer movements and vehicle routes, dimensions of radii, aisles, driveways, stalls including the two (2) feet overhang, and a scaled drawing at 1" = 20'. Contact City Traffic Engineering if you have questions.
- 10. The Developer shall post a deposit and reimburse the City for all costs associated with any modifications to Traffic Signals, Street Lighting, Signing and Pavement Marking, and conduit and handholes, including labor, engineering and materials for both temporary and permanent installations.

Specific questions regarding the comments or conditions contained in this letter should be directed to the commenting agency.

<u>No</u> interior, exterior or structural demolition or wrecking activities or remodeling activities (including material reclamation activities by the applicant or a third party) shall commence nor any wrecking or building permits be issued until the applicant has met all of the conditions of approval stated in this letter.

Please now follow the procedures listed below for obtaining your conditional use permit:

- 1. Please revise the plans per the above conditions and file **seven (7)** sets of complete, fully dimensioned, and to-scale plans, along with the appropriate site plan review application and fee pursuant to Section 28.206 of the Zoning Code. Also provide any other documentation requested herein with the Zoning Administrator, Room LL-100, Madison Municipal Building, 215 Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard.
- 2. This letter shall be signed by the applicant to acknowledge the conditions of approval and returned to the Zoning Administrator when requesting building permit approval.
- 3. No alteration of this proposal shall be permitted unless approved by the Plan Commission, provided, however, the Zoning Administrator may issue permits for minor alterations. This approval shall become null and void one year after the date of the Plan Commission unless the use is commenced, construction is under way, or a valid building permit is issued and construction commenced within six months of the issuance of said building permit. The Plan Commission shall retain jurisdiction over this matter for the purpose of resolving complaints against the approved conditional use.
