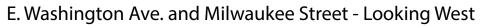

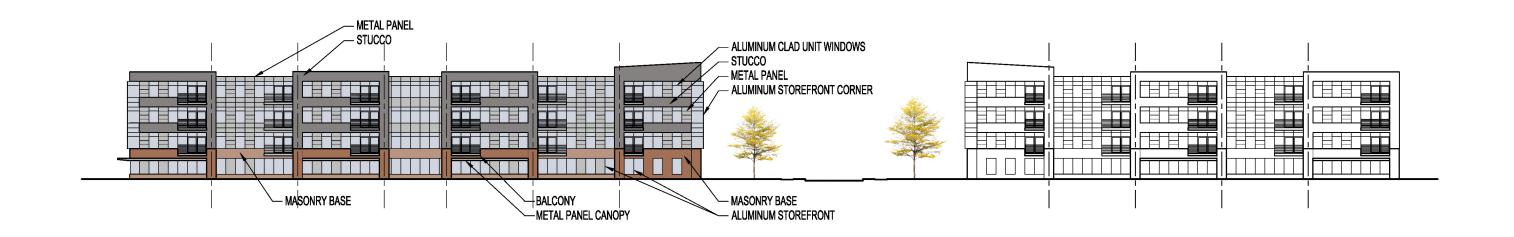

UNION CORNERS RESIDENTIAL PHASE I – BRIEF NARRATIVE DESCRIPTION

The Union Corners Development Project consists of two - four story, mixed-use structures facing Winnebago Street. Resident parking will be located in the basement of each building. The ground floors shall have a mix of retail spaces, resident common spaces as well as live-work units. Levels two – four of each structure will be comprised of a mixture of one, two and three bedroom units.

The project will also include off street parking for both the residents and retail tenants/visitors. The placement of the structures and landscaping will work with the existing master plan in place for the Union Corners site.
