Submitted is a request for funding in the amount of \$1500.00 for a Blink Grant to design and build the "Part of the Landscape Bench". This bench is intended as a functional art work set in a public space, for public use.

The Concept:

The "Part of the Landscape Bench" is a new ergonomic design that invites the audience to sit and talk together. The flowing, twisting organic form is an extension of the natural environment. It will both recede into the landscape and become a focal point in an urban park setting. This Biophilic design draws us in providing a center of interest for commonality. As a useful and functional object it will provide a place to wait for the bus and watch your kids play.

The Project Description:

This bench is made from White oak and stainless steel. Three 2" by 3/8" stainless steel strips will be bent into the curvilinear form defining the bench seat. 1" thick oak boards will be fit, shaped and screwed to the steel strips. The surface treatment of the wood will be smooth with all edges rounded and sanded. White oak has been selected based on it's durability in the exterior. No attempt will be made to apply a finish to the wood, rather it will be allowed to weather to a natural grayish color, creating a patina that is advantageous both as a protective layer and aesthetically. Stainless steel tabs will be welded to the base of the bench, and either bolted or staked to the ground for security. Safety has also been incorporated into this design, omitting any sharp or protruding corners.




