REPORT

The BID Board voted to approve adopting the recommendations of the Ad Hoc Downtown Public Restroom Committee with the following amendment:

In the first "Now therefore be it resolved" clause, adding the language: "It is not the city's intention to require a private developer to pay for the construction and operation of a public restroom in a private development project as a condition of approval for the proposed project."

The Board also recommended that any maintenance costs for a future public restroom not be funded through Mall Maintenance special charges, and clarified that BID would not be a source of funding or public restroom maintenance costs.
