SUMMARY:

Matt Tucker, Zoning Administrator, in attendance to explain the amendment.

Tucker explained that the sign code needed to codify he process as it exists which requires Certificates of Appropriateness for sign alterations and installations in historic districts and on landmark sites or for the Landmarks Commission to draft a policy to allow administrative approvals of changes of copy. Tucker explained that the sign code language is being changed to point to the Landmarks Ordinance.

Levitan explained that when the revised ordinance language that requires Certificate of Appropriateness for signs is approved, the ordinances will be mutually associating.
