MGO 27.05(2)(z) All residential buildings containing two or more dwelling units and/or lodging rooms where the main entrance door for the dwelling units is accessed from a common area, shall be equipped with doorbells intercoms or an effective buzzer system capable of alerting the occupants of specific dwelling units of requests for access to the building that pertain to their individual units.
2. The rule being petitioned cannot be entirely satisfied because:  
The system in place in the building calls phone numbers registered to units. Building Inspection is requiring that it call phones hardwired in units. Phone lines in building have become corroded over the years of water issues in basement, not all can be found and made to work.
3. The following alternatives and supporting information are proposed as a means of providing an equivalent degree of health, safety, and welfare as addressed by the rule:  
The call system has been in place in the building for 7-8 years. Residents have been given their choice of which phone number(s) they want the buzzer system to call. They have, so far, requested cell phones be the call numbers, not hardwired phones. If any residents request that the buzzer system ring a hardwired phone in their unit and the wires can be made to work, then it will be set up that way at the building management's cost.
