Hi ABC,

We were going to come to the TPC tonight to testify against Metro's idiotic plan to destroy ridership in the Marquette neighborhood by temporarily (during that street's reconstruction) putting the Jenifer St. buses onto East Washington. It appears that that will not be part of tonight's public hearing. Is it really too late to prevent Metro to shoot itself in the foot (and head) by eliminating ridership in the Marquette neighborhood? No one I talked to will walk all the way over to East Washington to catch the bus.
