2017 Public Health Policy Revision

The Child Nutrition Reauthorization Act of 1998, requires annual mandatory health inspections of all school food service facilities participating in the National School Lunch or School Breakfast Programs. DPI and DHFS enter into this Memorandum of Understanding in order to coordinate such inspections and to assist schools in complying with health standards in HFS 196.

The Child Nutrition and WIC Reauthorization Act of 2004 requires all schools participating in the National School Lunch or School Breakfast Programs shall, at least twice during each school year, obtain a food safety inspection conducted by a state or local governmental agency responsible for food safety inspections. DPI and DATCP enter into this Memorandum of Understanding in order to coordinate such inspections, to implement and monitor a school food safety program and to assist schools in complying with food safety standards in Wis. Admin. Code ch. ATCP 75.

City and County fees were established and have not changed since 1999.
