Safe Food Advisory Committee

The purpose of the Safe Food Advisory Committee is to advise staff on improvements needed in the food safety inspection program, evaluate industry food safety training, identify food employee training needs, and discuss emerging food safety concerns and how they can be addressed by the Department and the food service industry.

Public Health Madison and Dane County (PHMDC) would like to reform the membership of the Safe Food Advisory Committee in order to meet the criteria in Standard #7 Industry and Community Relations of the FDA Voluntary Retail Food Program Standards.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the committee be comprised of approximately ten industry representatives. PHMDC is committed to advancing Health and Racial Equity. Therefore the makeup of the committee should be reflective of the diverse community. There will be a concerted effort to attract and retain racially and ethnically diverse representatives on this committee. These operators are identified by PHMDC who have indicated a willingness to work with the Department in improving Public Health within the food industry with assistance from Department staff, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Safe Food Advisory Committee be comprised of at least one consumer representative that is a Dane County Resident.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Committee will meet as a whole or in issue-oriented groups at least two times per year, with a report to the Board on its activities each year.
