SUMMARY:

On October 3, 2000, the Common Council adopted Resolution No. 61179, approving the Objectives and Criteria for the Façade Improvement Grant Program. The resolution specifies that all Façade Improvement proposals be referred to the Urban Design Commission for comments and recommendations.

Attached for your review is the following Facade Improvement proposal:

1. 11 N. Allen Street

Grantee: Evan Gruzis

The scope of the exterior work will include:

- a. Install operable over-door transoms.
- b. Restore fascia and soffits matching the profile of the existing bead board.
- c. Install new, more historically accurate light fixtures.
- d. Replace lower glass with satin etched glass.
- e. Repair the foundation wall.
- f. Restore wood trim components around the storefront windows.

- g. Install retractable awning.
- h. Install gutters and downspouts.

Total project cost for 11 N. Allen Street exterior work is estimated at \$23,280.57. Façade Improvement Grant not to exceed \$10,000.

RECOMMENDATION:

Landmarks Commission reviewed this project at their July 31st meeting as the property is located in the University Heights Local Historic District. They issued a Certificate of Appropriateness for the scope of work included in this application.

The previous tenant at this address was awarded a Façade Improvement Grant of \$8545 in 2008 that covered limited improvements exclusive to the tenant portion of the building facade. The building has since been sold and the new owner, as part of this application, is making improvements and restoring the entire exterior. The Façade Improvement Grant Program Staff along with the Economic Development Director have determined that it is appropriate to award a second grant to this property based on the expanded scope of work that will be completed. The above Façade Improvement Grant meets the requirements of the program and the Staff Team recommends approval of the above Facade Improvement Grant proposal.





- 1 Lower obscure glass sections replaced with satin etched glass
- 2 Fixed over-door transoms restored with operable hopper window replacements
- 3 Concrete restored and painted
- 4 Window framing scraped, re-caulked and repainted
- 5 Failing soffits / gutters replaced
- 6 Fixtures replaced with higher quality 1920's style versions more appropriate to age and style of building
- 7 Window trim to be restored, including new lower horizontal barges, replacing areas of wood rot as needed, investigation of new crown, and new window jams as needed.
- 8 Window trim, side doors and related wood work to be scraped and repainted
- 9 Retractable awning or awnings depending on final design and brick integrity

Note: All work, design, and materials to be approved by the Wisconsin Historical Society and will be appropriate to historical character of the building and district.
