WHEREAS, the City has the authority to prohibit the carrying of firearms at City parking garages under Wis. State Statute Sec. 943.13(1m)(c)4 which states that a person is trespassing if:

"While carrying a firearm, enters or remains in any part of a building that is owned, occupied, or controlled by the state or any local governmental unit, excluding any building or portion of a building under s. 175.60 (16) (a), if the state or local governmental unit has notified the actor not to enter or remain in the building while carrying a firearm or with that type of firearm. This subdivision does not apply to a person who leases residential or business premises in the building or, if the firearm is in a vehicle driven or parked in the parking facility, to any part of the building used as a parking facility."

and;

WHEREAS, the Transit and Parking Commission has the authority to approve the posting of signage in City Parking Utility garages that would prohibit the carrying of firearms in all garages where notice is posted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Parking Utility shall post signage prohibiting firearms at all existing and future City Parking Utility garages.
