She suggested that everyone submit objections so you might start seeing those. It seems to me that people will like the changes except for the parking piece. If you could make an accommodation for work trucks who are going to be parked for a defined period, maybe issue a permit of some kind, it might help get the support you want. The permit process wouldn't have to be onerous, just an email to the office saying what work is being done and the timeline for trucks to be present, or a blanket permit for regular work like yard work at a certain address. The truck could put the permit email on the dash just in case a ticketing vehicle is making rounds.
